FC.14.09.01 <u>Introduction and Apologies</u>

Members were informed of the expected visit to the meeting of

a

representative from St. Andrew's Church.

There were no apologies.

FC.14.09.02 Declarations of Interest

CR declared an interest in item 4 (i) in respect of her position as

Chair

of Governors at New Earswick Primary School and took no part

in the

decision.

FC.14.09.03 Minutes of the Last Meeting

The minutes of 12<sup>th</sup> June 2014 were approved as a correct

record and

signed by the Chairman.

FC.14.09.04 Grant Applications

(i) New Earswick Primary School - £4,350 was requested to

install an

automatic winder for the school clock.

As the school clock is also a village asset the committee felt that

the

Council should consider making a grant to cover the full cost of

the

installation - £4,350 plus VAT (£870), plus the cost of the

small

amount of electrical work required (a new double socket).

(ii) St.Andrew's Church - £2,220 was requested for the

refurbishment

of the Hall floor.

Prior to our discussion Mr. Blanshard from St. Andrew's

addressed the

meeting and gave a full and interesting account of the work at

the

church. The committee were impressed with both the pastoral

care and

the efforts being made to renovate the building. They

recommend that

the Council make a grant of £3,700 (£2,220 for new flooring

for the

lobby, etc., plus £1,480 for restoring the Hall's wooden floor.

FC.14.09.05 Assets Register

Following an explanation from SB regarding the listing of

several new

items purchased in the last few months the committee were

agreed that

no further changes were required.

FC.14.09.06 Financial Risk Assessment

The Council's Financial Risk Assessment was examined in

detail and

no alterations were considered necessary.

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FC.14.09.07 Transparency Code

Members were informed of the Government's decisions

regarding

various aspects of the new Code following a period of

consultation. It

was noted that the Code, which will replace the external audit,

is not

due to come into force until the year 2017.

FC.14.09.08 Next Meeting

It was agreed that the next meeting of this committee should

take place

at 9.30 a.m. on Thursday 4<sup>th</sup> December 2014.

## N.B.

Following the meeting RR and SB carried out an inspection of the "street furniture" assets of the Council - two bus shelters, three benches, four salt bins and a notice-board. All were found to be in a satisfactory state of repair, although some of the salt bins require minor attention.
